Honoring and Resting in the Lord as we build

- God's Word will not return to Him void, but shall accomplished what He sends it to do: - NOTE, the people of the captivity during Ezra's and Nehemiah's time would not

heed the Word to honor the Sabbath and keep it Holy. So God caused the land to honor His Sabbath without the presence of the people.

- The people's dishonor of God cause the House of God to be burned when the Babylonians captured the city.
- God will be glorified , even if He has to have pagans to lead in that glory - Cyrus, a so-called pagan king, lead the rebuilding of the temple and returned the sacred artifacts that had been taken by the Babylonians.

2Ch And them that had escaped from the sword carried he away to Babylon; where
36:20 they were servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia:

2Ch To fulfill the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had
36:21 enjoyed her sabbaths: [for] as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfill threescore and ten years.

2Ch Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD
36:22 [spoken] by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and [put it] also in writing, saying,

2Ch Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD
36:23 God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which [is] in Judah. Who [is there] among you of all his people? The LORD his God [be] with him, and let him go up.

All of this came about because the people refuse to honor god! Another similar situation was seen among the people of Moses' time in the dessert see Hebrews scripture below.

Hbr So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.
3:19

Hbr 4:1 Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left [us] of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.

Hbr Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace that we may obtain
4:16 mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
