Dr. Corinthia Boone Ezra 6:16-23; 8:21-23; 9:5-15; 2 Chronicles 15:9,5; 23:16; 29:5; 34:31-33; Nehemiah 8:1

- We must engage the cultures with the standard of God's Word that there might be a generational transfer.
