Dr. Corinthia Boone – Ephesians 4:16-17

 We gain strength through prayer. Prayer builds us up and empowers us to strengthen the Body; we should follow Christ & speak the truth. Let us deal with the truth in all things and thus become more like Christ – each part helps the other so that the whole is healthy & growing. Ephesians 6:23 compels us to pour out our hearts; keep praying at all times in the spirit, keeping alert with all perseverance.

Pastor Rudy DePass - Isaiah 55:8

• His ways are not our ways -- God sees & knows the depth of the problems/issues we face, and wonders why we don't seek Him for our solutions. I noted that I've tended to be too anxious about what's around me – being influenced by the news media, rhetoric of others, etc., instead we need to do as David instructs in many of his psalms – cry out to God; or, as Mark says in Mark 11:24 -- speak to our mountains in faith; or say as Moses said in Exodus 33:15 – Lord, I won't go unless you go with me; or, recall from history what God has done for his own in the past; for example, he opened the Red Sea in His time & season; therefore, we need to be still and know that God is God.

Pastor Carlos Penaloza – Ephesians 4:10-11

- God has given us gifts to the body of Christ, along with special grace and empowerment from Heaven to be a blessing to the body of Christ; the question for us to ask ourselves is: Am I functioning in all of the gifts He has given me for the body of Christ – so that the body of Christ can manifest the strength of Christ.
- We need to cry out for God's mercy & forgiveness, for God to strengthen us and release everything to us.

Pastor Steve Eun – John 14:21 & 1 Corinthians 13

 Jesus commands us to love one another; if we love one another, Jesus will love us through His word – when we show ourselves to Him, he will show his power to us. As in Psalm 2:2, 8 – 9 David cried out in prayer; also, the Prophet Jeremiah exhorts us to cry out and call upon His name.

Bishop Bobby Holmes – Acts 4:29-32
