

The Focus of the October 30th Prayer Conference Call

Dr. Corinthia Boone – Psalm 100:4 & Matthew 18:20

- We enter into His gates with thanksgiving...
- Where two or three are gathered in His name...
- We come to have worshipful prayer & thanksgiving
- We invite the Holy Spirit to take control of our minds & our words
- That this time will bring glory & honor to God as we come according to your command
- Together we petition God for His covering as we pray unto Him; that His Kingdom will be enhanced
- Let the Kingdom of God be realized
- God promised to go before us – level mountains, give us the treasures hidden in the darkness & we'll know you're doing this

- Dr. Boone mentioned that she wrote a letter to the Washington Post, in the name of professional journalism, protesting the biased reporting about Sunday's rally.

Pastor Rudy De Pass – Isaiah 45:1- 3 & II Chronicles 36:22 – 23. The theme is that God will anoint Pastors in the DC Metropolitan Area with the CYRUS anointing so see our efforts against same-sex marriage come to fruition (In the spirit of Jeremiah speaking words from the Lord)

- That the leadership of the movement will not be afraid and continue to be a witness in the city
- That Pastors will take authority – bind and loose, possess & occupy the territory, cast out demonic strongholds in the name of Jesus
- That ungodly leaders be replaced with godly leaders
- That we'd make intercessory prayer and fasting our life-style
- We petition God to transfer the wealth of the unrighteous to his righteous to be used for His purposes
- That our youth will see the unfolding of God's hand and become caught up in it and dare to perpetuate it in their lifetime

Dr. Hernando Caicedo – Hebrews 6:1-3. The theme is collective repentance for being idle while the enemy gained ground

- Repent for the sins of others – so we bring the heart of God into these people to be in tuned to the heart of God
- Repent for the sins we allowed the community to commit
- Repent for the homosexuals & prostitutes, so that collectively we as a body, can bring the heart of God W/I them; so we can feel what they feel & thus be lifted to the level of holiness & righteousness that he wants to bring us to.

Bishop Joseph Hughes – II Corinthians 10:3 – 5; II Chronicle 7:14. The theme is that we have the weapon of prayer

- We do not war in the flesh
- One of our weapons is prayer – we thank God for this mighty weapon
- We pull down every strongholds, every unclean spirit that try to exalt itself against the knowledge of God
- Life & death are in the power of the tongue
- Warfare power is in the blood of Jesus
- We want to make God look good
- We tear down every stronghold
- We acknowledge that things we don't see you see
- Thank God for victory through prayer

Apostle John Drew, Sr. – Ephesians 1:15, 17 & Galatians 5:1. The theme is that Pastor's eyes of understanding, as Pastors, will be enlighten & we'll have understanding of what God's saying

- That our eyes will be open to see, by the spirit, what the Lord is saying
- That we'd be attentive to the word of God
- As we use the word, our knowledge will be enhanced, therefore when we gather, our prayers will be powerful
- What we do by His word is faithful – knowing the word via revelation; that we'd not speak w/o revelation from God
- That we'd pray with one voice, mind and understanding
- In short, God is speaking and we need to hear him through his word & revelation
