

## The Focus of the March 12<sup>th</sup> Prayer Conference Call

Dr. Boone's summary of the prayers of the morning – what the Holy Spirit gave her at the conclusion of the morning prayers (in response to DC crisis)

### *Present cycle*

I Peter 1:7 – Trials are only to test your faith -- Amos 8:11

- To see whether or not it is strong and pure
- Your faith (in God) is far more precious than gold; so, if your faith remains strong after being tried in the test tube of fiery trials, the results may rebound to praise, glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ

I Peter 2:3b – 7b

- The Holy Spirit is at work in our hearts, cleansing us that we may be pleasing to Him
- He allows these trials to test our faith -- our trust and confidence in Him (II Kings 6:15 – 18) to guide us through this cycle
- Trials provide opportunities to release His required response (Worship –Holy of Holies, glory & revelation) He guides us through revelation in this cycle & opens our eyes to see
- View what's happening from a high & lofty place:
  - a. Power to receive with faith that which God is doing in the cycle
  - b. Anointing to stay in the fight
  - c. Renewed in strength, healed & refreshed
  - d. To move into the fullness of His purposes
  - e. Humbling ourselves, taking courage, seeking His face – pressing into worship, allowing Him “to do the work” He has spoken of

This cycle postures faith and confidence

Psalm 4:1 – Hear me when I call, O God of our righteousness! You have relieved us in our distress; have mercy --, and hear our prayers.

Scripture: Hebrews 10:11 – 13

Focus: Thank you Lord for hearing our prayers

Scriptures: Genesis 19:29 & John 17

- God destroyed the cities of the Plain, God remembered Abraham & sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow before he overthrew the city where Lot dwelled. Lot tried to convince others to come out of the city that was doomed for destruction. Lot's trying didn't stop Abraham for interceding for the city
- Thank you that you did remember the prayers of Abraham & we thank you that our prayers are remembered
- There are some Lots to be rescued out of the mist of the coming judgement that will happen at some point or another. Thank you that our prayers are still heard as you remembered our prayers as you remembered the prayers of Abraham

### **Dr. Corinthia Boone**

Focus: We Press Forward with God's Word

Scriptures: Amos 8:11; Jeremiah 23:29

- A charge to keep that we are to continue to preach the word of God; our ministry should say I'm here as a witness to what the word of God says

- Jeremiah 23:29 – Is not my word like fire and like a hammer which shadows a rock. When the word is preached it's like a hammer;
- In the season we are in, we stay on task; we continue to preach the word; the charge is to you gatekeepers that we are to preach God's word from generation to generation
- The word hasn't been preached therefore there's no foundation to stand on. Lord, we'll not give up; you have a purpose for us & we are looking at a happier time. We are pressing in to understand your higher purpose for allowing us to be where we are now and we know that this is the wind of the Holy Spirit that's moving in our land to bring us to the unfolding of the purposes that you have for us now;
- We dust off our shoes and stay in the battle, with our time & our spirit connected to one another

### **Bishop Wayne Green**

Focus: Preach the Word with Boldness

- Lord, confirm your word with signs and wonders; demonstrate your power
- Thank you for your grace, mercy, long-suffering, patience, & for the opportunity you have given us to preach the gospel to every creature
- Thank you for you have given us the charge to earnestly contend for the faith which was first delivered unto the saints; we pray that we'd use this opportunity in areas of gross darkness and we charge that your light will shine even brighter in this dark hour
- We pray that as we preach your word in cities that have been given over to the powers of Satan, we'd preach it with boldness and that you will, as in the days in the book of Acts, confirm your word with signs & wonders

## **Bishop Bobby Holmes**

Focus: We're Overcomers

Scripture: II kings 6:15 – 18

- Strengthen us, with might by your spirit in our inner man; we pray for those who are struggling, for families & marriages on the front lines. Lord, will you strengthen them in the Name of Jesus as we stand fast and as we shore up our own marriages our own relationships as we declare that we'd win over every situation or circumstance
- We pray that you'd strengthen our hearts in the name of Jesus, for we declare and we know that we are winners this morning, and we will not let down our guard – as we look at our own relationships in our churches, in our families we know the enemy will try to destroy them but we take a stand in the name of Jesus Christ that we will not only be teachers of the gospel, but we'd model the word as well; as Joshua said, as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord, as we rededicate ourselves daily, to be an example. As Paul said to Timothy, let no man despise thy youth, but be thou an example to the believers.
- Regardless of what happens in this world we take a stand for righteousness in Jesus Christ; for we know that those who are with us are more than those that are against us
- Strengthen those on the front lines as church members eyes were opened—we need a new perspective of who God is; the servant could not see as the army of God was surrounding Syria;
- Help us to gain a new perspective of who you are; you are Jehovah Jireh, Nissi, we ask you to give us new vision as we know you have a greater purpose—we pray that our eyes are opened; you always cause us to triumph; close the eyes of the enemy
- Help us to hold each other accountable. Not to fear as we're victorious
- Elisha was a seer, he warned, church members that their eyes were open & the enemy's eyes were closed
- We know the darker things are, the brighter we shine; that the glory of God is released in us as we preach the gospel. That we'd take an even greater stand, that it will be testified concerning us. As Peter & John were unlearned men but they had this testimonies that they had been with God; regardless of our education, we pray that the light of Jesus Christ would shine bright through us during these dark hours
- We thank you that you have called us to preach, to teach & model the gospel of Jesus Christ; and, just as Jesus came & died and shined the light bright in the earth, we are the light of the world, we are the salt of the earth
  
- So father we take out stand, we are not discouraged, nor are we defeated. In the name of Jesus Christ we overcome fear, we overcome failure, we overcome frustration, we overcome fatigue; we will not allow the enemy to destroy our testimony or the word that you have placed in us;
- We arise God, knowing that you always cause us to triumph regardless of what situation we are facing, you always cause us to triumph.

- As gatekeepers, we already know that you understand what you are going to do; so we stand firm, we stand fast, we preach & live the gospel in Jesus name during these dark hours

### **Pastor Carlos Penalosa**

Focus: God guides us through cycles in our lives – cycles of prosperity

Scripture: Psalm 23:3

- Through cycles of prosperity, God brings us to fulfillment in our Lord, i.e., in the sense of bringing us to fulfillment with His purpose for our lives; and, if we achieve every goal that he has put in our lives, every cycle will come to completion & we'll achieve prosperity
- Lord, confirm your word with signs & wonders; demonstrate your power
- In Psalm 23:3, you restore my soul; the power of righteousness – guides me through cycles of prosperity
- We are his, we'll have his acceptance of approval if we follow him obediently; if so, this cycle that we are living in will end up in prosperity; as we continue being obedient, as we continue working with the knowledge that he is guiding us.
- The cycles are up & down; he is the one who makes the cycles; we might be on the lowest part of the cycle, but he's still there, but he will still prosper us because we are believing him, we are trusting him and we are working out of his shadow - - the shadow of the valley of the shadow of death, as we walk in his shadow, we'll not fear; this shadow gives light
- We must continue to believe in him regardless of the part of the shadow we live in
